NAP is an ACBL-wide grassroots competition that is held each year to encourage all members – from non-Life Masters through to top players – to compete for significant masterpoints and the possibility of a North American bridge title. This highly prestigious tournament begins with qualification sessions in bridge clubs (June through August), continues with the District Finals in the fall, and ends with the ACBL Finals at the Spring NABC.



Participants must qualify at a club in North America, be a resident of District 3, and be a paid-up member of ACBL.

First and second place pairs who qualify for the National event will receive a stipend from ACBL to play at the Spring NABC in Memphis.
